◇ Thank you for taking the time to complete the KIDS Parent survey. Your input is very valuable to us and greatly appreciated! It really helps us better our program. The following are only some of the comments we received:

Early Morning Drop Off: "Haven't used it yet, but love the option of having in there in case we need it." "I have used the early morning drop off once or twice. It is a nice addition this year."

Lunch Bunch: "We participate in the lunch bunch program on a regular basis. Our child enjoys the group and has made friends from other classes." "I have not used it mainly due to the price of lunch bunch. I would consider using it if the price were lower."

We really appreciate your feedback and ideas! And I want to make sure that you know you are heard. As a preschool, we are always trying to be developmentally appropriate for our students, and we recognized through experience that not every age level will do the same class activities. There are variations even among the same age level, not because the same concepts are not being taught but because they are being taught in a different way.

Many of our comments were about the new price of Lunch Bunch this year. I just want you to know that our lunch bunch rate is very competitive with other preschools, plus we offer it 4 days a week on an as needed basis until 2:00pm. It is a great opportunity for your child to have extra interaction with other children and teachers from other classes, while it gives you additional time to do whatever you need to do. As a parent, I have a child that really looks forward to lunch bunch because he gets the extra time to play with friends from other classes & I find it truly beneficial for his socialization.

◇ Thank you to those that came out to California Pizza Kitchen on our Spirit Day, January 25th. We made \$84 for our preschool.
